Council Minutes (*unapproved*)

August 12, 2009

The Canton Lutheran Church Council met for their monthly meeting in the Library, Wednesday at 8:00 p.m. Members present: Pres. John Devick, Vice Pres. Tracy Johnson, Secretary Joann Fossum, Treasurer Leon Eich, Pastor Tony Haglund, Pastor Jan Zoss, Janet Henke, Sharon Lunder, Jan Pudenz, Brenda Heggen, Julie Crawford, LeAnn Anderson, Keith Beachler, Kari Elling, Mary Toso and Mark Hennies. The meeting opened with the reading of the Mission Statement. LeAnn Anderson led devotions. A group of concerned parishioners were present to voice concerns of the upcoming votes at the National Church Assembly on the Social Statement on Human Sexuality and the issue of allowing gay and lesbian clergy if they are in a committed relationship. A video by Bishop David Zellmer was presented in which he stated that nobody knows how this vote will turn out, but if it passes it would be on the administrative level and individual churches would still be able to run their congregation as they wish. Pastor Tony explained that in 1983 the church body affirmed and in 1989 adopted that gays and lesbians are welcome. The South Dakota Synod has voted that they do not want the new proposals to pass; however, the constitution states the delegates are free to vote any way they wish. The Social Statement vote requires 2/3's majority to pass and the issue of gay and lesbian clergy in committed relationships requires a 50% plus one vote to pass. If the issues pass, a congregation has a choice to refuse to hire a gay or lesbian pastor, accept the concept or go through a process to leave the ELCA. The question of when a congregational meeting can be called was asked. It can be called by the council, by the pastors or a request in a signed petition by 10% of the baptized and confirmed members of the church (around 100 for CLC). Discussion followed and updates of the assembly can be found on the ELCA.org website.

The minutes were read and approved. Treasurer's Report: income for year as of the end of July, \$189,990 and expenses \$220,413, leaving a deficit of \$30,423.

Board of Trustees

Present: Keith Beachler and LeAnn Anderson. A motion was made and approved to pay bills. John Devick has put together a person to prep the parking lot for crack seal. The landscaping and rework in front of the church has been completed. There is a potential need for new gutters on the east parsonage, but that was put on hold for now. The east parsonage is still pending sale of the buyer's current home and the west parsonage is still being shown.

The Worship on Wednesday plan includes an after school program for kids called ROCK (Radically Outrageous Christian Kids) to help parents and students with their busy schedules. The child may come at anytime and parents may participate in the supper if they wish. From 3:00 to 5:00 will be ½ hour time periods with church based activities such as bells, music and video presentations with snacks provided. Homework time will be from 5:00 to 5:30 with help provided. Pizza will be available for \$1.00 per slice at 5:30. Wednesday School begins at 6:15 and starting August 26th Worship with Communion will be held at 7:00. Mary Toso and Cathy Mastalir have volunteered to

contact former teachers as to their availability to teach this year. Teacher and Shepherd's training is scheduled for Wednesday, August 26th at 6:00 p.m. with a baseball theme chosen and hot dogs, chips, etc. being provided. Parents are encouraged to register their children and currently 1/3 have registered for Wednesday, 1/3 for Sunday and 1/3 not yet registered. A backpack blessing will be given on August 23rd and August 26th during the services. The Fall Basket Ministry will be ELCA Hunger Ministry. The Winter Basket Ministry will be given to Lutheran Outdoors for playground equipment for Joy Ranch, which is a camp being designed to serve those with special needs. The Noah's Ark Party will be September 12th at 10:00 a.m. Sunday and Wednesday School begins September 13th and 16th. Confirmation classes will be held on Wednesdays from September through May with the curriculum being written by Pastor Tony, Pastor Jan and Kari Elling. Pastor Tony reported that the Wednesday night offerings have gotten bigger and the plan is to offer an after school snack with half hour sessions from 3:00 to 5:00 offering different stations and different things going on such as choirs, videos or activities. At 5:00 would be homework time or the reading of books. From 5:30 to 6:15 pizza will be offered for sale at \$1.00 per slice. At 6:15 confirmation would be held and 7:00 would be church services. It will be called ROCK-Radically Outrageous Christian Kids. It was decided to write our own confirmation guide and emphasize "Friendship with Jesus". Pastor Tony also

reported that Paul Konietzko has been hired as Worship Coordinator with a \$200.00 a month salary for administrative duties and \$60.00 a service for 100 services a year for playing the organ.

New Business

Pastor Tony encouraged everyone to fill out their Time & Talent sheets. He also reported that there was not enough savings to change our bi-monthly mailings of offering envelopes. The availability of on-line giving will be considered in the future. It was discussed as to when to hold council meetings in light of the new Wednesday night schedule. A motion was made and passed to continue to hold the council meetings at 8:00 p.m. on Wednesday with the individual boards deciding when they want to meet.

Next month's devotions and treats assigned to the Board of Deacons.
