

We talked a little bit of how you can build your relationship with the Lord, by evaluating how we spend the 1440 minutes a day that God gives us.


We played a game emptying a bowl of skittles and talking about the joy of what the empty tomb means. We are anxiously awaiting the joy that Easter brings.


If you are unable to join us in person for worship, please join us for Sunday Worship on the Canton Lutheran Church YouTube Channel for live worship.
