From the Pastor's Desk

As I try to wean myself off the sugar rush of eating cookies *every* day during the Advent/Christmas season, I look to the year ahead serving with you all at Canton Lutheran Church. Thank you for the ways you support this shared ministry!

In recent years I've adopted a theme word to begin the year fresh, inspired by a friend of mine. My word this year was gifted to me through a book from my spouse, Pastor Renee. The book is titled *The Generosity Habit*, by Matthew Kelly. The book consists of short, one-page "devotions" (it is not specifically a book of faith, although Kelly is himself a person of faith and speaks of God) as well as quotes from notable folk over the years including John Steinbeck, Mother Teresa, Nelson Mandela, and...*drum roll*...Taylor Swift.

Generosity does not consist of just money, it is a way of living. It is a way of being in the world, and interacting with all around us. Some of the people I cherish most happen to be steeped in it: Generous with their time, generous with their choices, generous with their heart and love and words.

Kelly reflects on his own mother's words:

"When I was young, my mother would say things like, 'That color looks great on you,' or 'I really like that shirt on you.' I was raised on encouragement...Different things look good on different people, but some things look good on everyone—and generosity is at the top of the list. Generosity looks good on you."
